BEARKAT BYTES

- Sam Houston is 1 of just 3 teams in the FCS, along with North Dakota State and New Hampshire, to reach the FCS playoffs each of the last 6 seasons. In that time the Kats have posted an impressive 14-6 mark, trailing only the Bison in playoff wins during that span. Sam Houston has reached at least the quarterfinals in 4 of those 6 seasons, including back-to-back trips to the FCS championship game in both 2011 and 2012.

- The Bearkats reached the double-digit win plateau for the third straight season and fifth of the last 6 seasons in 2016. In its 102-year history, Sam Houston has won at least 10 games 8 times (1956, 2001, 2004, 2011, 2012, 2014, 2015 and 2016).

- The Kats are 17-10 all-time in the FCS playoffs and own the country's third-best winning percentage (.629) in the playoffs. Last season Sam Houston made its sixth straight appearance in the FCS playoffs and 10th overall.

- With its win over Richmond in the season opener, the Bearkats secured the first season-opening victory over a ranked opponent in school history. It made Sam Houston 3-1 against current CAA schools and was the 16th victory all-time against a team ranked in the national top-10.

- Points have not been a problem under head coach K.C. Keeler for the Bearkats. In 48 games since he took over in 2014, the Kats have scored 30 or more points on 39 occasions, going 35-4 in those games. In all, Sam Houston has scored no less than 34 points in each of its last 28 victories.

BY THE NUMBERS

14

The Kats have won 14 games in a row at Bowers Stadium dating back to the 2015 season. That is the longest active streak in all of FCS.

34

Head coach K.C. Keeler claimed 34 victories in his first three years at the helm of the Kats. That is the most of any Bearkat head coach in his first three seasons in charge.

6

Sam Houston qualified for the FCS playoffs for the sixth straight season in 2016. That broke a tie with the McNeese squads from 1991-95 for the most consecutive playoff appearances by a Southland Conference school.

WITH A BEARKAT WIN ...

- K.C. Keeler would win his 212th career game. He is currently 18th all-time among FCS head coaches, one win behind Wofford's Mike Ayers. One spot ahead of Ayers on the all-time list is former SHSU head coach Ron Randleman, who sits 16th with 218 career wins.

- Sam Houston would win its seventh straight Battle of the Piney Woods, setting a new record for the longest win streak by either team in the history of the series. The current 6-game win streak over the Jacks is the second longest active win streak by the Kats over any current Southland Conference foe, with only their 11-game win streak over Nicholls being longer.

- Sam Houston would win its 72nd game since the beginning of the 2011 season. The Kats and North Dakota State are the only two teams in the FCS with 70 victories since the beginning of the 2011 campaign.

- The Kats would win their 10th consecutive game played in the city of Houston. That current streak dates back to the 2010 Battle of the Piney Woods and includes six wins over SFA at NRG Stadium, two wins at HBU and a win over Texas Southern at BBVA Compass Stadium.



LEFTOVER KATNIP FROM 41-30 LOSS AT CENTRAL ARKANSAS ...

- The loss to UCA snapped a 3-game win streak for the Bearkats over the Bears. It also snapped a 12-game winning streak in SLC play for Sam Houston that dated back to a 27-10 loss at McNeese in 2015.

- Jeremiah Briscoe threw for 303 yards and 3 TDs against UCA, giving him his 16th 300-yard passing game of his career. The 3 touchdown throws also gave him 84 for his career, tying him with former Bearkat QB Brian Bell for the career record at SHSU.

- The Kats got a big game from sophomore wide receiver Nathan Stewart as he finished with 8 catches for 164 yards and three scores, tying his career high in touchdown catches for a single game. He now has 18 touchdown catches in his career in just 17 games played and leads the SLC in receiving with 127.0 yards per game.

- Corey Avery rushed for 134 yards, becoming the Bearkats' first 100-yard rusher on the season. It was the 9th 100-yard rushing game of his career and his first since going for 212 yards in Sam's 2016 win at UIW.

- The Bearkat defense did not force a turnover against the Bears on Saturday, making the game the first this season Sam has not forced at least one turnover. In fact, it snapped a streak of 15 consecutive games the Bearkats have not had at least one takeaway, dating back to the 2016 season opener against Oklahoma Panhandle State.

- The teams combined for 29 penalties and 301 yards in the game with 12 penalties and 135 yards going against the Kats. The 12 penalties is the most since SHSU committed 13 in the 2015 Battle of the Piney Woods, and the 135 penalty yards were the most since SHSU was penalized 16 times for 159 in the 2014 season opener against Eastern Washington.

KATS SEEKING BACK-TO-BACK SOUTHLAND CROWNS

Last season Sam Houston ran the table on its way to winning the outright Southland Conference title with a perfect 9-0 mark. The Kats are looking to win back-to-back league crowns in 2017 for the first time since 2011 and 2012, but have never won consecutive outright titles. The last team to win two straight outright SLC crowns was McNeese in 2006 and 2007.

STAYING AT THE TOP

The 2016 season was the first time in school history the Bearkats not only started the year ranked in the top 5 of the national polls, but also stayed there throughout the year. Sam Houston opened up the season as the No. 2 team in the STATS FCS poll and eventually rose to No. 1 midway through the year before finishing ranked No. 5 in the final poll. Currently they are ranked No. 9 in 2017, and since K.C. Keeler took over the program prior to the 2014 season, the Bearkats have been inside the top 25 polls each time a poll has been released. Additionally, the last poll without the Kats in the top 10 was on Nov. 9, 2015.

BRISCOE SETS FCS TOUCHDOWN MARK IN 2016

When Jeremiah Briscoe threw for 5 touchdowns against Chattanooga in the second round of the 2016 FCS playoffs, it moved him past Mississippi Valley State's Willie Totten (1984) and Grambling State's Bruce Eugene (2005) for the all-time FCS record with 57. His mark was just one touchdown shy of tying Colt Brennan's Division I record of 58 set in 2008, and 4 short of tying Linfield's Brett Elliott who holds the NCAA mark (all divisions) with 61 touchdowns in 2004. He is on the verge of owning another record as he has 84 touchdown passes for his career and needs just 1 more touchdown pass to move past Brian Bell for the all-time touchdown pass record at SHSU.

ALL GAS, NO BRAKES

'Don't Blink' was the mantra for the Bearkat offense in 2016, and it fit, considering how quickly the Kats would strike once getting the ball. Sam Houston scored 89 offensive touchdowns a year ago, with 54 of those drives taking up less than 2 minutes on the game clock. This year the offense has adopted 'All Gas, No Brakes' as its motto, carrying over its quick-strike ability into 2017 with 13 of their 23 touchdown drives taking up less than 2 minutes.

KATS CLAIM PAIR OF MAJOR AWARDS IN 2016

The Bearkats racked up on postseason awards in 2016 with no awards bigger than Jeremiah Briscoe claiming the Walter Payton Award as the nation's top offensive player and head coach K.C. Keeler taking the Eddie Robinson Award as the nation's top coach. It was the first time either award has gone to a Bearkat or a member of the Southland Conference. It is also just the second time in history 1 program has claimed both awards with the pair joining Villanova's Brian Finneran and Andy Talley who claimed the awards in 1997.

Appalachian State's Armanti Edwards (2008 & 2009) is the only player to repeat as the winner of the Walter Payton Award, while North Dakota State's Craig Bohl is the only coach to win the Eddie Robinson Award in consecutive seasons (2012 & 2013).

KATS AMONG WINNINGEST TEAMS SINCE 2011

Since the 2011 season which saw Sam Houston State make a run to the the first of consecutive FCS Championship games, the Bearkats have managed to sustain their success. The Kats, along with North Dakota State are 1 of only 2 FCS teams with at least 70 wins since 2011. They have also been one of the most successful in all of Division I football. Here's a listing of where the Bearkats rank in wins since the 2011 season:

The Bison own the best postseason record in the country in that stretch, despite having their undefeated (22-1) streak in FCS post-season play snapped in the 2016 FCS semifinals against James Madison. Meanwhile, the Kats stand at 14-6 with two trips to the finals and reaching the semifinals two other times in that span. With a 17-10 overall record in the FCS playoffs, Sam Houston ranks third all-time in playoff winning pct. (.653) and seventh in total wins among current NCAA FCS programs.

HALL MONITOR

The Bearkat defense received a big boost against the Colonels with the return of all-America defensive lineman P.J. Hall. The senior was suspended the first two games of the season, but made his 2017 debut on Saturday. Hall finished second in the voting for the Buck Buchanan Award for the national defensive player of the year in 2016, and has picked right up where he left off in games against Nicholls and Central Arkansas, and is closing in on Southland and FCS records. THRICE AS NICE

With an offense as prolific as the Kats' was in 2016, it's no surprise that the ball was spread around. Sam Houston boasted a pair of receivers - Yedidiah Louis (1,152) and Nathan Stewart (1,004) - who surpassed 1,000 yards receiving in 2016. Davion Davis finished just 40 yards of the mark, keeping the Kats just short of joining the 2013 and 2014 Fordham squads as the only teams in FCS history to sport three 1,000-yard receivers on the same roster in the same year. Currently the Kats' Big Three each rank in the top 7 in the Southland in receiving yards per game with Nathan Stewart leading the way, ranking sixth in the nation with 127.0 yards per game.

BALANCED RUSHING ATTACK FOR THE KATS

Sam Houston has had its fair share of feature running backs in its history, but this year's talented backfield corps seems to do things more as a whole. The Kats feature a quartet of backs who the coaches deem can play in any situation, but only Corey Avery has managed to surpass the 100-yard rushing mark to this point after his 134-yard effort against UCA despite the Kats averaging 202.5 yards per game on the ground as a team. It was the first time since the 2006 season that Sam Houston has not had a 100-yard rusher within its first three games of the season.

RECORDS UP FOR GRABS FOR LOUIS

In the Kats' playoff win vs Chattanooga in 2016 wide receiver Yedidiah Louis moved past Matt Dominguez for the all-time Sam Houston mark in career receptions and stretched that out to an SLC record 235 with 17 snags this year. Against Richmond he became just the third player in Southland Conference history to reach 3,000 yards receiving for a career and now he needs 115 more yards to pass Dominguez for both the SHSU and SLC record for career receiving yards. He also needs just 5 more touchdown receptions to tie Dominguez's school record of 27 for his career.

PUNTERS ARE PEOPLE TOO

The Bearkats have had the last two first team all-SLC punters, and Cameron Hearn may very well be the next in line to hold up that mantle. But against Prairie View he was not used as the Bearkat offense did not use the punt team once in the win over the Panthers. Aside from 6 scoring drives, 1 drive ended the half, another ended the game and a third finished in a turnover. It was the first time the Bearkats have navigated an entire game without a punt since Sept. 25, 2014. That was a span of 166 games.

PRICE IS RIGHT

The SHSU coaching staff quickly knew they had something special in safety Josh Price when he joined the team prior to the 2016 season. He played 2 years at Southern Nazarene to open his collegiate career, but sat out the last 2 seasons, including 2016 due to NCAA transfer regulations. But he opened his Bearkat career by picking off 2 passes against Richmond, both ending Richmond drives in the red zone. The second was a game-clinching pick with 2:03 to play with the Spiders driving inside the SHSU 10-yard line and made him the first Bearkat with multiple picks in a game since Mikell Everette had 2 against Central Arkansas in 2015 - a span of 19 games.

30-PLUS SEASONS AT BOWERS

During Sam Houston's 100th season of football in 2015, the Bearkats also played their 30th year at Elliott T. Bowers Stadium.

Sam Houston owns a 130-44-1 record on the turf at Bowers. The Bearkats have gone 40-2 in their last 42 appearances at home.

Known as Bearkat Stadium when the facility opened on Sept. 13, 1986, with a 24-6 victory over Montana State, the name was changed in 1989 to honor Dr. Elliott T. Bowers upon his retirement as Sam Houston State University President.

The Kats won their first 13 games at Bowers and have posted undefeated home seasons in 1986, 1987, 1990, 1992, 2001, 2004, 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2016.

BOUNCE BACK KATS

Since the beginning of the 2011 season the Kats have only felt the sting of defeat 21 times, and more often than not they have responded the following week. In that span Sam Houston has only dropped consecutive games on four occasions, with the last time coming in 2015 when it lost to Texas Tech and Lamar to open the season. Additionally, the Kats have not dropped back-to-back regular season games to FCS opponents under K.C. Keeler, last doing so in 2013 when they fell to Southeastern La. and Central Arkansas in consecutive weeks to close out the regular season schedule.

KATS PLAY CATCH-UP FOR FIRST TIME IN A WHILE

Sam Houston has made a living out of playing from in front under head coach K.C. Keeler, but Saturday's game vs UCA did not fall into that category. The Bears scored in the game's first two minutes and never allowed the Bearkats to go out in front. The last time the Bearkats played a regular season game in which it never held a lead was in 2015 when the Bearkats fell 49-46 at home to Lamar.

TOUGH SLEDDING OUT OF THE GATE

With four games under their belt, the Berakats' 2017 schedule has done them no favors to date. Of the four games played, three have come against ranked FBS opponents, including most recently then No. 11 Central Arkansas. Since joining the Division I ranks for the 1986 season, Sam Houston has never played three ranked FCS opponents within its first four games of the year until 2017.

SIGNING CLASS RANKED AMONG NATION'S BEST

With plenty of talent returning to the roster in 2017, the Bearkat coaching staff made sure that the well would not run dry in the future, signing one of the nation's top recruiting classes in February. According to Hero Sports, the Bearkats' 18-member, all-Texas signing class was ranked fourth among all teams in the FCS. Highlighting the group was defensive back Tyon Merchant who Hero Sports named the No. 1 signee in the nation. K.C. Keeler's staff also added Ty Brock, who was named as the No. 5 overall signee and top quarterback signing in the nation. Here is a listing of Bearkat signees ranked in the top 250 by Hero Sports:

YOUTH ON THE EDGES

Following 2016, Sam Houston revamped its defense with 8 new starters, but no defensive unit is more overhauled than the secondary. Junior safety Adrian Contreras is the only 2016 starter to open the Nicholls game in the secondary. In fact, the Kats started a pair of true freshmen - Jaylen Thomas and Zyon McCollum - at the 2 cornerback positions against the Colonels. The frosh duo helped Sam Houston hold the Colonels to just 11-for-27 passing for 136 yards in the game. They are each listed at the top of the depth chart for this week against SFA.

KAT FACTS

With 171 more receiving yards, sophomore **Nathan Stewart** would already move into the SHSU top 10 in career receiving, joining teammates **Yedidiah Louis** and **Davion Davis**.



BEARKAT ATHLETICS

• Sam Houston is the only league member to win the Southland Conference Commissioner's Cup all-sports trophy 5 times (2005, 2006, 2007, 2013 and 2014). The Bearkats also have won the Southland men's all-sports cups 5 times and 1 women's cup.

ABOUT SAM HOUSTON STATE

• Sam Houston State University is located in Huntsville, Texas, with the 316-acre campus approximately 65 miles north of downtown Houston.

• It was founded in 1879 and stands today as the third-oldest public university in Texas. Created to train school teachers, today's Sam Houston offers a broad range of academic programs leading to bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees.

• The university's namesake, Sam Houston, was the first and third president of the Republic of Texas. Houston was an American politician and soldier. His victory at the Battle of San Jacinto secured the independence of Texas from Mexico in one of the shortest decisive battles in modern history, lasting only 18 minutes.

• Sam Houston is buried in Huntsville not far from the campus of the University which is named in his honor. He was the only man in United States history to be governor of two states (Texas and Tennessee).

• The university, which is the 12th largest in Texas, passed the 20,000 student mark in enrollment in the spring of 2015 and currently boasts 20,477 enrollees.

• Sam Houston's most recognizable alumnus is Dan Rather -- American journalist and former news anchor for CBS Evening News. The university named its mass communications building after Rather in 1994.

BOTPW RIVALRY FACTS

- Since 1923, Sam Houston and SFA have competed together in three conferences – the Lone Star, Gulf Star and (since 1987) the Southland.
- This year's matchup marks the ninth time the Battle of the Piney Woods has been held in Houston. The Kats and the Jacks battled to a 14-14 tie in the Astrodome in 1976.
- This year's Sam Houston vs. Stephen F. Austin meeting marks the 92nd renewal of the Battle of the Piney Woods, making the game the third oldest continuous college football rivalry in Texas.
- During the 1930s, The Battle of the Piney Woods was an annual Thanksgiving Day event.

SHSU-SFA QUICK HITS

- The Bearkats versus Lumberjacks series dates back to 1923. Sam Houston holds a 54-35-2 edge in the series with a pair of ties. The Kats have won six straight, tying the longest win streak in the series which was last done by Sam Houston between 1937-1946.
- The matchup has been played at NRG Stadium each of the past seven years with the crowds growing larger each season. Sam Houston defeated Stephen F. Austin 63-28 on Oct. 1 last year before a record crowd of 27,411 fans at NRG Stadium.
- Since 2007, the winner of the Battle of the Piney Woods has earned a 21-pound solid cedar trophy that displays replica pistols from Texas' frontier past. The logos from both universities are engraved on the handle of the pistols above name plates that will display the outcomes of the contest for the next two decades.
- The 92nd Battle of the Piney Woods presented by H-E-B again will be one of the top FCS games of the 2017 season. Each of the past eight game winners has gone on to advance to the NCAA post-season playoffs. Six of the last eight years, the winner of the rivalry game has emerged as champion of the Southland Conference.
- Since 1986, one team has come into the Piney Woods game in the FCS top 25 and the other not ranked 16 times. Six of those games, the unranked team won.

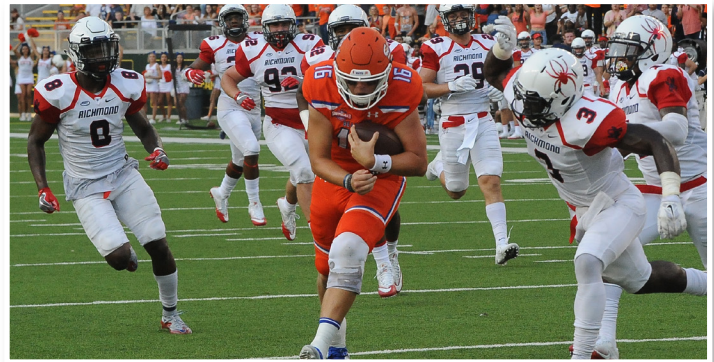
